DOG-FRIENDLY DETAILS

The Ozark Mountains are a great place for a family vacation and your dogs are family too! We invite you to bring your four-legged friends along, but ask that you follow our dog-friendly rules.

- Owners are legally responsible for the actions of their dogs.
- The property may exclude a dog if in the properties sole discretion the dog is considered dangerous or likely to frighten, harm, or disrupt other guests.
- A maximum of two (2) dogs are allowed in each accommodation. Each dog must weigh 50 lbs. or less.
- Dogs must be current on all vaccinations, flea control, and must wear a current rabies tag. Dogs must comply with legal legislation requirements.
- Guests are responsible for any damage or disruption dogs may cause. If a deep cleaning is necessary or neighboring guests are disturbed, an appropriate fee will be added to your accommodation.
- Keep your dog(s) on a leash. Leaving dogs unattended is prohibited. Handlers must monitor and control their dog(s) at all times.
- Aggressive dogs must be immediately removed from the property and will be permanently barred from staying.
- "Scoop your poop." Owners must clean up after their dogs. Dog waste stations are located throughout the properties.
- Dogs may not be left alone in accommodations unless in a travel kennel.
- Dogs may not be left unattended in any vehicle on property.
- Housekeeping services need to be pre-arranged with the Front Desk so that the dog is with their owner, or out of the room, during service. The Front Desk will contact you to arrange the cleaning schedule for day service and turndown.
- Your dog occupancy door hanger must be displayed on the outside of your accommodation door at all times.
- Dogs are not allowed in the pool areas.
